Save Nuclear Medicine

1. To Stop Classification of PET/CT under Radiology*: Many government health departments have categorized PET/CT procedures under the domain of Radiology, which may lead to Radiologists taking over these diagnostic techniques. This classification may not accurately represent the expertise and unique role that Nuclear Medicine specialists play in interpreting and using PET/CT scans for diagnosing and treating various medical conditions.

2. To stop classification of Radionuclide Therapies under Radiation Oncology*: Similarly, the classification of Radionuclide therapies as part of Radiation Oncology in programs like Ayushman Bharat can result in Radiation Oncologists performing treatments that traditionally fall within the purview of Nuclear Medicine. This misclassification can create confusion and competition between these two specialties, potentially compromising patient care.

3. *Personal Experience and Nationwide Issue*: My personal experience in Delhi highlights the fact that many Nuclear Medicine practitioners across India may be facing similar challenges. These challenges can include legal disputes, administrative hurdles, and competition for patients. Your aim is to raise awareness of these issues to ensure that Nuclear Medicine specialists can provide optimal patient care without unnecessary obstacles.

In summary, my goal is to advocate for the proper recognition and classification of Nuclear Medicine procedures and therapies, preventing the encroachment of other medical specialties, and ultimately ensuring that patients receive the best possible care from Nuclear Medicine specialists without legal, administrative, or competitive hindrances.
